There are various types of portable toilets distinguished by their structure, function, and characteristics.

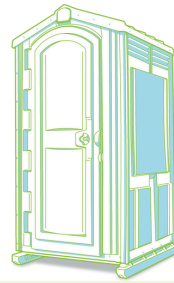


## Construction

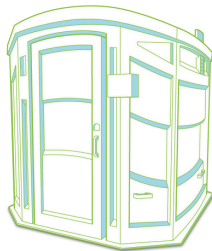
- Dimensions: W:3.7' H:7.3' D:4'
- Ventilation and locking features are standard.
- Standard porta potties include a chemical toilet and toilet paper.
- Other features may include a mirror, coat hook, or hand sanitizer.

## Event

- Dimensions: W:3.7' H:7.3' D:4'
- Tend to be newer than construction standard toilets
- Event standard portable toilets tend to be newer than construction standard toilets.
- A good rule of thumb is one toilet for up to 50 guests for an event.



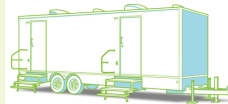
## ADA Handicap-Accessible



- Dimensions: W:5.6' H:7.5' D:7.2'
- Provide additional space to accommodate wheelchairs and similarly sized mobility devices.
- Feature safety assist bars to provide extra support for those who maneuver in and out of wheelchairs.
- Frequently ordered for outdoor weddings and family events.

## Restroom Trailer

- Create a like-home experience on wheels.
- These luxury portable toilets usually have multiple stalls and stairs or ramps leading into the trailer.
- Interiors are fitted with full-sized sinks, mirrors, and upscale finishes such as faux wood floors and chrome fixtures.



## Handwashing Station

- A portable handwashing station comes equipped with hands-free foot pump faucets for extra no-contact cleanliness.
- Includes liquid hand soap, paper towels, and waste trash bags.
